From ancient times, Bupleurum root has been widely used in the traditional medicine of China and Japan.<sup>1</sup> Rehmannia and Bupleurum were first mentioned in the *Divine Husbandman's Classic of the Materia Medica (Shen Nong Ben Cao Jing)*. This Chinese text is believed to have been written at or before the 3<sup>rd</sup> century – although herbs were being used in China for millennia before this time!<sup>2</sup> Because of its unique set of actions, there isn't a single herb in the Western herbal tradition that can match Bupleurum.<sup>3</sup>

In the ancient literature of India, Hemidesmus root has been mentioned as a very important herbal remedy. It was called to the attention of medical practitioners of the United States and Europe in 1832, and was admitted into the *British Pharmacopoeia* in 1864. (Pharmacopoeias provide standards for the identification and preparation of medicines. The word comes from the Greek 'pharmakon', a drug, 'poiia', making. They are usually published by the authority of a government, medical or pharmaceutical society.)

Studies using Feverfew conducted in the late 1990s established that the component parthenolide was associated with Feverfew's health benefits.
