



MediHerb® Golden Seal 500mg tablets contain *Hydrastis* canadensis, a highly valued traditional herb. Golden Seal has been extensively studied and understood to contain two uniquely identifying isoquinoline alkaloids: berberine and hydrastine.¹ While there are several herbs that contain berberine, only Golden Seal contains hydrastine, to which its unique mucous membrane properties are understood to be attributed.¹ Due to its endangered status, Golden Seal is a high-cost raw material, and is vulnerable to substitution with other, low-cost herbs. Substituted herbs usually contain berberine, which provides the characteristic yellow color; however, they do not contain hydrastine, which is unique to Golden Seal.

MediHerb® uses high-pressure liquid chromatography (HPLC) to differentiate true Golden Seal from other berberine-containing herbs. MediHerb® tests each batch of Golden Seal raw material to ensure the correct species is used with the identification of hydrastine.



Healthy Mucous Membranes – The First Line of Defense

Mucous membranes (MM) line body cavities that are directly exposed to the exterior environment including the entire digestive, respiratory and reproductive tracts, and much of the urinary tract. They consist of a layer of epithelium and an underlying layer of connective tissue united by protein complexes known as tight junctions (TJs).^{2,3} They form part of the innate immune system and represent the first line of defense (physical barrier) against the outside environment.

Mucous membranes also secrete mucous, which functions to trap particles in the respiratory and gastrointestinal tracts (GIT), and lubricate food as it moves through the GIT. When particles from the outside world get trapped in MMs, they can stimulate an immune response. This causes MMs to swell, resulting in secretion of excess mucous, and increases the permeability of TJs, allowing these particles to breach the body's defenses stimulating a greater immune response.²

Golden Seal - King of Mucous Membrane Tonics

Golden Seal is known by traditional herbalists as 'the king of mucous membrane tonics," and traditional clinicians in the late 19th-century were especially enthusiastic about Golden Seal. It was highly regarded as being advantageous to the mucous membranes, and was used to maintain and promote healthy mucus production. As a mucous membrane tonic, natural healthcare practitioners use Golden Seal to improve the tone, vigor and function of the mucous membranes.
