**MediHerb Hawthorn** contains a standardized herbal extract of Hawthorn, which provides the equivalent of 1 g of dry Hawthorn flowers and leaves and 6 mg of the flavonoid vitexin-2-rhamnosides per tablet.

Both the leaves and the flowers of this herb contain phenols and flavonoid with antioxidant activity.<sup>1-3</sup> These antioxidants can help assist in protecting the body against many sources of oxidative stress, such as ultraviolet (UV) light, atmospheric pollution, poor diet and stress itself.<sup>4\*</sup>

### Traditional Use

The traditional use of **Hawthorn** dates to the first Century A.D. when Dioscorides and Galen both referred to the herb. In the late 19th century in Europe and the United States, it became well used and sought after as a cardiac (heart) tonic and one of the most important traditional remedies for the cardiovascular and circulatory system.<sup>1,5-9\*</sup>






#### Antioxidant Activity Support:
