

Liver Tonic:

 Milk Thistle has been used traditionally for over 2000 years, principally as a liver tonic to promote overall healthy liver and gallbladder functions.⁴⁻⁶ This includes the production of bile, which is an important fluid that aids in the absorption and digestion of dietary components, as well as normal liver detoxification processes.*^{7,8}
